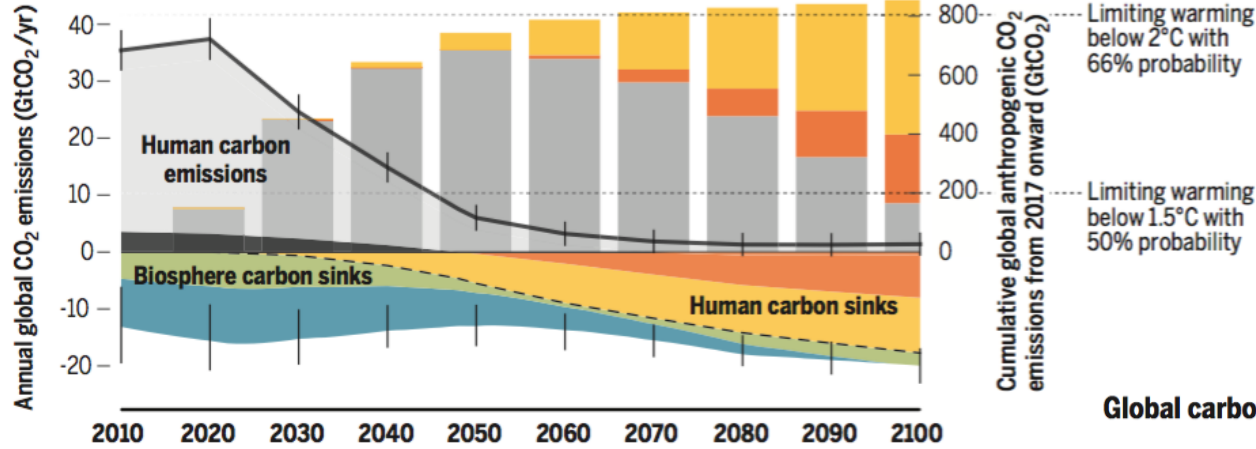

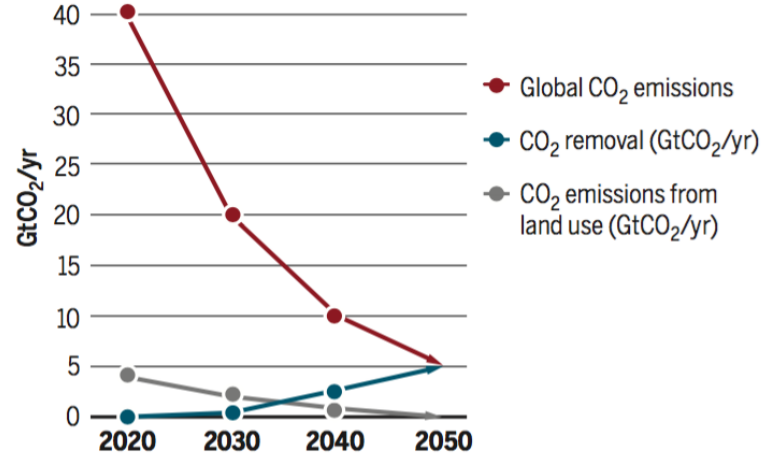

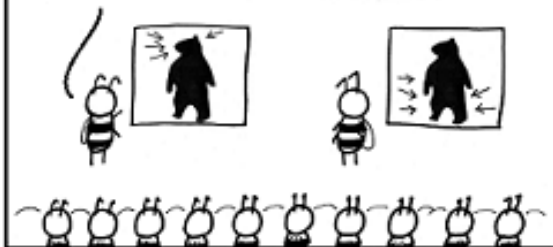
- Anthropogenic CO₂ emissions (gross)**
